## Apply



We start accepting applications on April 1, 2016. Find the application and a checklist to guide you at [www.cvdl.org/application](http://www.cvdl.org/application).

The time between April 1 and Nov. 1 (when applications are due) is your season of due diligence: read about the program on our website, attend an open house, discuss your interest with your colleagues and family, and assemble your application materials.

## Interview



Your completed application is due **November 1, 2016**. (After this date, applications will be considered only as space remains available.)

A faculty committee will review your application; if selected, you will receive a call to schedule an in-person interview. Interviews take place between September and January.

## Enroll



If you are accepted into the program, you'll receive confirmation from our program director within a month of your interview date.

You will have two weeks to confirm your interest and complete your financial agreement and other enrollment forms. Once the forms are submitted, we'll send your reading list, bios of your fellow cohort members, and more exciting program details.
